CLASS 1 VETERAN DOG (2 entries)

1st – Mizani Dorocco Raffaele (Mr T Grantham) – 9 years old. Lovely type, masculine head, eyes of good shape and colour. Good coat in nice condition. Good angulation front and rear, good bone and feet. Moved well with drive.

2nd – Gaesten Top Tinker (Mr K J & Mrs S C Tollerfield) – 7 years old. Masculine head, good neck. Soft topline. Good coat. Good angulation, bone and feet. Too close behind on rear movement.

CLASS 2 PUPPY DOG (4 entries)

1st – Mad Max Madiba Of Freworth (IMP ITA) (Mrs J Whitworth) – 11 months. Lovely head, eyes of good shape and a nice colour. Good coat. Topline a little soft. Correct croup. Good angulation, bone and feet. Moved well for his age.

2nd - Clamerkin Brown Onyx (Mr C James) – 11 months. Masculine head. Coat too long on the head, overgroomed. Good neck. Topline a little soft. Good croup. Good coat for age. Good bone and feet. Movement needs more maturity.

CLASS 3 JUNIOR DOG (3 entries)

1st - Arcticbreeze Now Or Never (Mr K J & Mrs S C Tollerfield) – Lovely masculine head, very nice eyes of good shape and colour. Good neck, topline, croup and tail. Good coat. Little long in loin. Good bone and feet. Moved well.

2nd – Whitworth's Mad Max Madiba Of Freworth

CLASS 4 NOVICE DOG (2 entries)

1st – James' Clamerkin Brown Onyx

2nd - Clamerkin Tawny Emperor (Mrs J Drake) – Good head for age. Eyes of good shape and a nice colour. Good coat but not at its best today. Good angulation, bone and feet. A little short in croup. Needs more experience in the ring to see good movement.

1st - Dario Della Caveja (Mrs L Ferguson) – Very nice type. Well balanced. Lovely masculine head, eyes of good shape and nice colour. Good neck, topline and tail. Very well angulated, good bone and feet. Moved very well with drive.

CLASS 7 OPEN DOG (2 entries)

1st - Truffalusa November Moon From Mizani (Mrs L Ferguson) – Lovely breed type. Very well balanced. Very nice character. Lovely masculine head, with eyes of good shape and nice colour. Good neck, topline, croup and tail. Excellent angulation, good bone and feet. Good coat in nice condition.

2nd - Arcticbreeze Turbulence At Allsong (Mr S & Mrs B L Whittick) – Masculine head. Eyes of good shape and a nice colour. Good neck and topline. Short in croup. Good front angulation, very good rear angulation. Good bone and feet. Good coat.

CLASS 8 VETERAN BITCH (3 entries)

1st - Mizani Diorbe Of Vienna (Mrs L & Mr J W G Monk) – Lovely bitch with lovely feminine head, eyes a good shape and nice colour. Good neck, topline, croup and tail. Good angulation, good bone and feet. Lovely character. Good coat.

2nd - Nelbekio Be It Bambalina (Mrs K & Mr B Bransby) – 8 years. Feminine head, good shape and colour eyes. Correct ears. Good neck, topline and tail. Well angulated, good bone and feet. Good coat.

CLASS 9 PUPPY BITCH (4 entries, 1 absent)

1st - Made Chianti For Timtaurn (Mrs A Stephenson) – Well balanced puppy. Lovely and sweet feminine head. Eyes good shape and nice colour. Good neck, topline, croup and tail. Nice coat for her age. Very well angulated, good bone and feet. She has super movement.

2nd - Clamerkin Painted Lady (Mrs J Drake) – Well balanced, with feminine head. Eyes of good shape and nice colour. Lovely character. Good neck. Topline a little soft at the moment. Good group and tail. Well angulated, good bone and feet. Moved well for her age.

CLASS 10 JUNIOR BITCH (4 entries, 1 absent)

1st – Stephenson's Made Chianti For Timtaurn

2nd - Mianatra Ever So Elegant (Miss R DeBlasi) – Lovely type. Feminine head, good eye shape and nice colour. Good neck, topline and tail. Good coat. Good angulation, bone and feet. A little long in loin.

CLASS 11 NOVICE BITCH (4 entries, 1 absent)

1st – Drake's Clamerkin Painted Lady

2nd - Arcticbreeze Aerodynamic (Mrs T A Colonna) – Feminine head. Good shape eyes of nice colour. Good size. Good neck, topline and tail. A little short in croup. Correct angulation, bone and feet. Good coat.

CLASS 12 POST GRADUATE BITCH (3 entries)

1st - Greenbankes Kara (Miss S Tindall) – Lovely feminine head. Well balanced. Good neck, topline and tail. Lovely character. Good coat. Good front angulation and very good rear angulation, good bone and feet.

2nd - Marleydown Dimensional Dot At Mianatra (Miss R DeBlasi) – Lovely feminine head, eyes of good shape and nice colour. Lovely character. Topline a little soft. Good croup and tail. A little long in loin. Good angulation, bone and feet. Moved well.

CLASS 13 LIMIT BITCH (5 entries)

1st - Havana King Of The Truffles To Byphar (IMP SER) (Mrs K Roberts) – Well balanced female. Lovely character. Feminine head, good shape and nice colour eyes. Good neck, topline and tail. Good coat. Excellent front angulation, very good rear angulation, good bone and feet. Moved well.

2nd - Mikette How Far I'll Go To Clamerkin (Mrs J Drake) – Lovely female. Nice size. Very nice character. Good head, eye shape and colour. Good neck, topline, croup and tail. Good coat. Well angulated, bone and feet. Moved well.

CLASS 14 OPEN BITCH (3 entries, 1 absent)

1st - Allsong Nuova Luna (Mr S & Mrs B L Whittick) – Lovely size. Well balanced, lovely feminine head, with good eye shape and colour. Good coat. Good neck, topline and tail. Well angulated, good bone and feet.

2nd - Gaesten Dannys Delight At Joydon (Mr D H Lightfoot) – Good size. Well balanced. Good shape and colour eyes. Coat not in the best of condition today. Soft topline, good croup and tail. Good angulation, bone. Down in pasterns in front. Moved well.
