Venue: Cowdray Estate, near Midhurst, West Sussex GU28 9BX

Judges: Mr Jason Mayhew [A3701] & Mrs Anna Mayhew [NP]

Timing: Meet at 9.00 a.m. for a 9.30 a.m. start

Definitions: Stakes may be limited to 16 dogs

Puppy: For dogs or bitches aged between 6 and 18 months on the date of the Assessment Tests
Dogs will be expected to demonstrate: Walk to heel, sit and stay, recall, seen retrieve, hunting, and water retrieve

Novice: Any dog or bitch not to have been placed 1st in a Novice Test, nor 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Test, nor to have been given any Field
Assessment Trial Award including a CoM
(Unclassified) Dogs will be expected to demonstrate: Hunting, steadiness to shot or command, seen and/or unseen retrieve, and water retrieve

Open: Open to any dog or bitch
Assessment (Preference will be given to dogs not eligible to run in the other Tests)
(Unclassified)

Awards: Certificates for 1st-3rd places and Best Hunter in each class
A Certificate will be awarded to the Best Lagotto Romagnolo in the Assessment
The Iteru Trophy will be awarded to the Judges' Choice Lagotto Romagnolo
COMs may also be awarded at the discretion of the Judges

Entries & Fees: **£10.00 per dog for LRCGB members / £15.00 per dog for non-members. Entry forms to be received by e-mail no later than Tuesday, 20th August 2024, together with payment via BACS** (details on Entry Form). The draw will take place by an independent person at the Working Sub-Committee Chair's home on Wednesday, 21st August. Entries will be confirmed no later than Saturday, 24th August

Dummies: Dummies will be supplied by the Lagotto Romagnolo Club of Great Britain

Lunch: Competitors should be self-sufficient
